

# Cause and Effect Display

**Directions:** Choose one of the two methods listed below to demonstrate your understanding of the migration of humans to different regions of Mexico.

## **Method One:**

1. Create a map with a detailed key to show two different areas of Mexico to which large populations of humans have migrated. Use symbols to create representations for the population, landforms and natural resources.
2. Create a second map with a detailed key using symbols to show the climate and industries of Mexico.
3. Using the two maps, draw conclusions about what effects the humans have had on the land, resources, and environment as a result of their interaction. Write them on an index card that is attached to the maps for display.

## **Method Two:**

Identify two different areas of Mexico to which large populations of humans have migrated. Research the approximate population, landforms, and natural resources. Find out what the climate is and how humans use the natural resources. Draw several conclusions about what the effects of the interaction of humans have been on the land, resources, and environment. Combine all of this information into well-written detailed paragraphs for your display.
